



Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you... and I will send down the showers in their season; they shall be showers of blessing.

JEREMIAH 29:12 | EZEKIEL 34:26

■ **Pray anytime. Pray anywhere.** You may fast. You may also want to prayerwalk your neighbourhood, workplace or campus.

■ **Pause to synchronise prayer** twice a day at 11am and 11pm wherever you are.

■ **Pray round-the-clock** with your church or organisation or network.

■ **Use this simple guide** to prompt prayers. Reflect on the Scriptures and prayer points for each day. Allow the Holy Spirit to pray in and through you. Where it says *the lost or the unsaved or unbelievers*, personalise your intercession by mentioning specific persons by name. Pray deeper into each situation as you know it.

APRIL 20 *You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses*

(ACTS 1:8). ■ Thank God for the awesome privilege to witness for Christ across our city. ■ Thank God for the Holy Spirit who empowers us to boldly share Good News with family, friends, colleagues, classmates, neighbours, and even strangers. ■ Thank God that this holy power is available to any believer who proclaims the Risen Saviour to any unbeliever—anytime, anywhere!

APRIL 21 *Your people will volunteer freely in the day of your power; in holy array, from the womb of the dawn*

(PSALM 110:3-4). ■ Thank God for the day of his power. Thank God, he chooses that day. Thank God, we believe that day is here! ■ Pray for the whole Church to rise up in formation as ONE consecrated army, ready for battle: the battle for souls, the battle for the future of our nation's spiritual wellbeing. ■ Volunteer your life as a freewill offering to serve the Risen Christ, Lord of the Harvest.

APRIL 22 *Lord, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, Lord. Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy*

(HABAKKUK 3:2). ■ Celebrate God's great grace and mercy shown in the 1930s through John Sung and in the 1970s through Billy Graham. ■ Plead with God to visit us again in yet another historic move of the Spirit. ■ Ask God for the gift of desperation, a deep yearning for a grand harvest, even greater than in 1978.

APRIL 23 *I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams... And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved*

(ACTS 2:17, 21). ■ Pentecost is about harvest. Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Spirit. ■ Ask God to reveal Christ to the unsaved through words of prophecy, visions, and dreams—towards a Great Homecoming!

APRIL 24 *The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise*

(PROVERBS 11:30). *He who gathers in summer is a prudent son, but he who sleeps in harvest is a son who brings shame* (PROVERBS 10:5). ■ Pray for a Singapore Awakening. ■ Ask God to stir his sons and daughters to behave responsibly and serve selflessly in this hour of national harvest. ■ Pray that no church will be found wanting, but that all will honour the Father by pulling together, putting feet to vision through CoH.

APRIL 25 *If my people which are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land*

(2 CHRONICLES 7:14). ■ Pray for God's grace and mercy. On behalf of our nation, ask him to forgive us our sins of idolatry, immorality, and injustice. ■ Ask God to heal our eyes to see him, heal our ears to hear his voice, heal our hearts to believe and receive Christ as Lord and Saviour.

APRIL 26 *Repent... turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord*

(ACTS 3:19). ■ In identification with the Church, repent: For being more interested in the trivia and temporal than God's mission and the eternal. For procrastinating in reaching out to the lost. For our unbelief that this rich and thriving First World nation can turn Godward. ■ Ask God for a fresh move of his Spirit and ignite in each believer a passion for his Name.

APRIL 27 *When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd*

(MATTHEW 9:36). ■ Pray for eyes to see the spiritual plight of fellow Singaporeans (80%) headed for Eternity without Christ. ■ Pray for ears that hear their desperate cries behind their fake smiles. ■ Pray for Jesus' profound compassion for the lost. ■ Pray for transformation: from apathy to action, from passive spectators to passionate shepherds.

APRIL 28 *The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few... pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest*

(MATTHEW 9:37-38). ■ Pray for a mighty move of the Spirit to buck the trend. That instead of a labour shortage, there shall arise countless numbers with a burning vision for Singapore's salvation, starting with the lost in our own circles. ■ Pray for great success in engaging the lost, bringing them to the rallies, and leading them to Christ.

APRIL 29 *For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes*

(ROMANS 1:16). ■ Contend for a revival marked by great joy to identify with Christ and great enthusiasm to proclaim him. ■ Contend for a shift in church culture where evangelism is a top ministry priority and a personal lifestyle. ■ Contend for a new norm: A Spirit-filled Church with *beautiful feet and burning lips of love*, spreading Good News in wise and winsome ways.

APRIL 30 *Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven*

(MATTHEW 19:14). ■ Ask God to fill our little ones with a holy excitement to invite their family and friends to the first-ever national rally for children. ■ Speak blessings over them: You are arrows in the hands of our mighty King. You are warriors and witnesses set apart for his purpose. You are doubly anointed to pray, praise, persuade, proclaim, and prepare the way of the Lord!

MAY 01 *I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me out; I'm just as vigorous to go out to battle now as I was then. Now give me this hill country that the Lord promised me that day*

(JOSHUA 14:11-12). ■ Pray for those in their golden years to arise as *Calebs*: strong in spirit, fervent in faith, vibrant in vision, battle-ready! Godly models of courage, conviction, determination, and devotion to Christ. ■ Ask God to reward their soul-winning passion with an abundant harvest of seniors at CoH.

MAY 02 *I have great sorrow and unceasing grief in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were accursed, separated from Christ for the sake of my kinsmen... my heart's desire and my prayer... is for their salvation*

(ROMANS 9:1-3, 10:1). ■ Pray: O God, over 80% in this city are lost without Christ. Grip us with the reality of hell and judgment. Burden us with godly sorrow and a great sense of urgency to devote our time, our energy in reaching out to them, especially those closest and dearest to us.

MAY 03 *For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul?*

(MARK 8:36). ■ Ask God to supernaturally awaken the lost to the futility of life without Christ. ■ Ask God to grant them divine encounters, causing them to experience a deep and great (1) distaste for worldly pleasure, (2) disillusionment with false securities and empty belief systems, and (3) disgust with pride and selfish ambitions. ■ Ask God to put in them a holy curiosity for meaning and purpose in life.

MAY 04 *God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him*

(1 JOHN 4:9). *The Lord is patient, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance* (2 PETER 3:9). ■ Declare: God loves Singapore. God desires for every person to experience new life in Christ. ■ Ask God to stir within the lost an intense longing for inner peace, forgiveness, freedom from guilt, sense of belonging, true love, and abiding hope.

MAY 05 *Indeed, we live as human beings, but we do not wage war according to human standards; for the weapons of our warfare are not merely human, but they have divine power to destroy strongholds*

(2 CORINTHIANS 10:3-4). ■ Declare: At the Cross, Christ has already defeated Satan and cancelled all his claims over the souls of men. ■ Ask God for grace to speak Truth and show love in ways that disarm the arguments of those who spurn the Gospel and scorn the messengers.

MAY 06 *I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase*

(1 CORINTHIANS 3:6). ■ Pray for abundant sowing of the Gospel among all ethnic groups across all ages and class divides: Heartland families. Elderly poor. *Crazy Rich Asians*. Movers and shakers. Scholars. Students. Niche influencers. Migrant workers. New immigrants. Irreligious yuppies. Religious devotees. Hardcore liberals. ■ Pray for massive and miraculous conversions, triggering a Jesus movement in our city!

MAY 07 *The seed will grow well, the vine will yield its fruit, the ground will produce its crops, and the heavens will drop their dew. I will give all these things as an inheritance to the remnant of this people*

(ZECHARIAH 8:12). ■ Declare: We will look beyond the natural. We will fix our eyes on our promise-keeping God. We will double our efforts with joyful hope. ■ By faith, we thank God for a Great Homecoming, a national harvest of epic proportions beyond our wildest dreams!

MAY 08 *You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows* (PSALM 23:5). ■ Speak blessings over the CoH Team that they may experience: Our Father's lavish love. Supernatural protection. Daily rejuvenation in God's presence. Fresh anointing. Clear mind. God-inspired thoughts. Overflowing power of the Spirit. Holy zeal to keep step with God who shepherds their souls and supplies all their needs. Christ in them, the Hope of Glory!

MAY 09 *Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God* (PSALM 20:7). ■ In this extraordinary time, pray that we will fix our eyes on Christ and wait on him with expectant hearts, confident that he who began a good work in Singapore will complete it excellently, beyond imagination. ■ In repentance, renounce all reliance on worldly ideas and human talents, our past experience and track record of success. ■ Declare that our trust is in Christ alone!

MAY 10 *Without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him* (HEBREWS 11:6). ■ Pray for ALL to persist in faith, not intimidated by the *goliaths* or the gigantic scale of CoH, but inspired by the greatness of our God, and fired up by his promise of a bumper harvest. ■ Reject the tactics of the enemy to discourage us. ■ Ask in faith and receive the greater things God has in store for us.

MAY 11 *The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God* (2 CORINTHIANS 4:4). ■ Declare: In the authority of Jesus' name, we nullify the works of darkness, we expose lies and deception, we speak light into the minds of the lost. For we do not proclaim ourselves but Christ, our Master and Messiah. God will reveal Christ gloriously to every soul at every rally!

MAY 12 *The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned* (ISAIAH 9:2). ■ Make this your cry: O Lord, come visit Singapore! Shine the light of your love and flood our city with the Father's glory. Reveal Jesus. Remove blinders. Unveil minds. Draw seekers and non-seekers alike to yourself. Astound us with mighty breakthroughs. Cause entire families and whole communities to turn to Christ suddenly!

MAY 13 *Oh that you would rend the heavens and come down... make your name known to your adversaries... that the nations might tremble at your presence... no one has heard or perceived by the ear, no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for him* (ISAIAH 64:1-4). ■ Raise a hallelujah to the Lord our God for there is none like him! ■ Welcome him to come visit our city in manifest presence and power, turning adversaries into allies for the Gospel.

MAY 14 *I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you* (LUKE 10:19). ■ Declare: In Jesus' name, we take authority over the forces of darkness, over all witchcraft curses levelled against CoH leaders, speakers, and testifiers. We nullify all demonic plots to confuse and divide God's servants. We speak shalom and divine covering over every detail of the rally plans and preparation.

MAY 15 *In those days ten men from the nations of every tongue shall take hold of the robe of a Jew, saying, 'Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you'* (ZECHARIAH 8:23). ■ Ask God to draw massive throngs of foreigners to Christ at every rally. ■ Ask God to mark CoH as a momentous turning point for Antioch missions where foreigner after foreigner will declare: *I belong to the Lord* (ISAIAH 44:5). ■ Pray for mighty ripple effects all across Asia and to the ends of the earth!

MAY 16 *Open up, O heavens, and pour out your righteousness. Let the earth open wide so salvation and righteousness can sprout up together. I, the Lord, created them* (ISAIAH 45:8). ■ Call on God to do all the awesome things that only he can do: Throw open the heavens. Rain down his Holy Spirit. Reveal Jesus. Illuminate darkened minds. Soften hardened hearts. Bend stubborn wills. Save lost souls. Turn Singapore Godward. Cause his righteousness to flourish forever and ever!

MAY 17 *For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven* (ECCLESIASTES 3:1). ■ Declare: There is a time to sow in tears, and a time to reap with joy. There is no God like our God who makes all things beautiful in his time. God's counsel stands forever. He has spoken and he will bring it to pass. *No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him* (1 CORINTHIANS 2:9). The Lord reigns, let Singapore rejoice!

MAY 18 *My word... that goes out from my mouth... shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it* (ISAIAH 55:10-11). ■ Declare: O Lord, your Word is alive and active. Your Word is powerful. Your Word is sharp. Your Word can cut through every doubt and defense. Your Word can pry open hearts to hear and obey Christ. Your Word shall prevail at every rally. By faith we rejoice in a Great Homecoming!

MAY 19 *Pray... that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel* (EPHESIAN 6:19). ■ Declare: God speaks. His voice is majestic. His voice thunders! God speaks powerfully through his servants. He will cause his Word to fall like rain on the good soil of tender hearts. He will reveal Jesus. All will see and know that God has spoken. The lost will turn from darkness to light, from the power of Satan to God!

WE SING to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day (PSALM 96:2). We declare: the stadium shall resound with worship, exalting Christ above all else. Our seismic praise shall throw the enemy into utter confusion, wrecking every demonic scheme, stronghold, and structure! Our songs shall be a pleasing aroma to the Lord. Our songs shall proclaim Christ, open the hearts of the unsaved, and draw them to Christ even before the preaching begins. *To God be the glory, great things he has done!*

WE PROCLAIM Jesus the Word became flesh and lived among us, full of grace and truth (JOHN 1:14). We proclaim Jesus, the Way, the Truth, and the Life (JOHN 14:6). We proclaim Jesus who reconciles us to God by his blood shed on the Cross (COLOSSIANS 1:20). We proclaim Jesus, the one Name by which we must be saved (ACTS 4:12). We proclaim Jesus, the Good Shepherd who goes after the one lost sheep until he finds it (LUKE 15:3). We declare this day: all who call on the Name of Jesus shall be saved!

WE DECLARE *Nothing is impossible with God* (LUKE 1:37). *Everyone who asks receives. Everyone who seeks finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened* (MATTHEW 7:8). We rejoice in every answer to every prayer. Answers that glorify the Name of Jesus. Answers that add new names to the Book of Life. We declare: The God of peace will soon crush Satan under our feet (ROMANS 16:20). We rejoice that every step of obedience to reach every soul becomes a crushing blow to the enemy!
